This September, you are encouraged and challenged to pray for our church, leaders, and members. Here are prompts for the first 5 days.

Day 8: Sunday School – “And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, commit to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.” 2 Timothy 2:2

Day 9: Marriage – “May your fountain be blessed, and may you rejoice in the wife of your youth.”

Day 10: To Make a Difference – “And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we don not give up.” Galatians 6:9

Day 11: Our Youth – “Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.”

Day 24: A Culture of Discipling – “And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.” 2 Timothy 2:2

Day 25: An Evangelistic Spirit – “For this is what the Lord has commanded us: ‘I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.’” Acts 13:47

Day 26: Thank God for His Unchanging Character – “But You are the same, and Your years will not come to an end.” Psalm 102:27

Day 27: Thank God for His Love – “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him shall not perish but have everlasting life.” John 3:16

Day 28: God’s Justice – “Therefore the Lord waits to be gracious to you, and therefore he exalts himself to show mercy to you. For the Lord is a God of justice, blessed are all those who wait for him.” Isaiah 30:18
